A large mass of underground water that can supply the entire country for 70yrs has been discovered in Lotikipi basin, Turkana County.

The find is said to be measuring 100km by 66km with a surface area of 4,164km².

The discovery in the Lotikipi Basin is said to be over 200 billion cubic metres of fresh water.

Lotikipi alone is now reported to be holding 900% more than Kenya's current water reserves.

The announcement of the discovery was made by UNESCO funded by the Japanese government in conjunction with the Kenyan government

They have been using satellite, radar and geological technology in a bid to find supplies of water.

This discovery, they say, will not only help Kenya but it could help other countries facing water scarcity.
